Reasons for Change

Cross-Country

Until now, cross-country purchasing was blocked within the platform, since was seen as a minor priority at the time NCE (New Commerce Experience) was implemented in StreamOne® Ion. However, as we start to migrate our partners from SCM to StreamOne® Ion we need to be able cross-country purchasing. With this feature, partners will be able to perform those purchases if customers are in the same country region as established by Microsoft.

Scope

We have expanded our platform's capabilities to allow the purchase of Microsoft products from different countries (See list [here](#)) in the same country region as established by Microsoft.

With this enhancement, Partners can now browse, select, and purchase Microsoft products from our platform regardless of their geographical location within the region where they are located.

Now when creating a new tenant, cross-country purchasing will be available by having the option to select a country under the region you are in.

For this reason, now you will see a new dropdown “Country or Region” where Partner can select the country within the Partner’s Microsoft PAC region that their customer is located in. For example, if you are Partner in France, you can choose a different country within his Microsoft Partner Center (PAC) region as shown in the image bellow to meet the location of the Customer during the tenant creation.
